Each completed membership application form MUST be accompanied by:

- Copy of current vehicle registrations for each vehicle listed on the application.
- Copy of current year’s county property tax statement.
- Check for membership fee payable to Suncrest Park Association.
- **If applicant is NOT the property owner, an ORIGINAL Property Owner Release form must also accompany the application. This form must be notarized and the property resident must also include Proof of Residency.
- **Boat slips are also available for an additional fee of \$200. If interested, please include the completed Boat Slip Rental Agreement form and a separate check for the applicable fee.

***A copy of the Suncrest Park Regulations is attached to the application and should be retained by the applicant, not sent with the application. **Additional forms can be downloaded from www.suncrestpark.com.**

Only property owners and renters in the Suncrest developments, as specified in the Association Bylaws Article 1, Section 2, shall be eligible for membership. Memberships are non-transferable and cannot be collectively used by others. The membership is on an annual basis from May 1st to April 30th each year. All items listed above are required for membership eligibility. Each approved applicant will receive two keys and up to three vehicle decals (determined by vehicles listed on application, attached vehicle registration, and additional fee). No additional keys are available for purchase. Replacement decals and/or keys require a petition to the Park Board. Each petition will be reviewed and determined on a case by case basis.

- Membership applications and ALL accompanying documentation will only be accepted through mail services to the address listed on the application. DO NOT leave applications at the park gate or mail box outside of the park gate.
- Vehicles without properly affixed decals are NOT allowed in the park, unless pre-approved by the park board.
- Vehicles parked inside the park gates without a current membership decal will be towed at the owner’s expense, as specified in the bylaws, Article 1, Section 2.
- Decals MUST be affixed to the outside of the vehicle windshield on the **top driver’s side corner**. Any decals affixed incorrectly will not be permitted in the park and the member will be required to purchase a replacement decal for \$5. **To assist with visibility, remove any previous year’s decals from windshield.**

SUNCREST PARK REGULATIONS

General:

SUNCREST PARK IS A NON-PROFIT PRIVATE UNSUPERVISED PARK. ALL MEMBERS AND GUESTS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR THEIR OWN SAFETY AND BEHAVIOR. PARK DIRECTORS OR EMPLOYEES ASSUME NO DUTY TO ENSURE OR ENFORCE COMPLIANCE.

- A. ALL VEHICLES ENTERING THE PARK MUST BE REGISTERED TO THE MEMBER. All members must have their current decal affixed on upper corner of the windshield on driver's side. Gate must be locked after entering or exiting the park.
- B. **No pets are allowed inside the park, except when loading or unloading at the boat ramp.**
- C. Law prohibits minors from being served or drinking alcoholic beverages.
- D. No one under the age of 18 is allowed inside the park after 10 PM without parental supervision unless posted as daily use.
- E. Children under the age of 12 are not allowed in the park without adult supervision.
- F. Weapons used for hunting purposes only, must be secured and unloaded inside your vehicle or boat while on park premises.
- G. All other weapons are not allowed on park property.
- H. No fireworks.
- I. Members are responsible for their guests. Members and guests are to behave in an acceptable manner. Abuse, negligent behavior or offensive language will not be tolerated.
- J. No overnight camping.
- K. Absolutely NO HUNTING on park property.
- L. No tobacco or E-cigarette use in beach area, playground area, or within 25 feet of bathroom area.

Parking:

VEHICLES PARKED IN THE PARK WITHOUT A CURRENT REGISTERED PROPERLY AFFIXED DECAL WILL BE TOWED AT OWNERS EXPENSE.

- A. Park in designated areas only. Please do not park on the grass. 5 MPH speed limit.
- B. Water recreational trailers only in the lot next to the entrance.
- C. Only vehicles properly licensed are allowed in the park.

Boat Launch and Docks:

- A. Members, dependents and guests utilize the docks, ramps and launch at their own risk. PLEASE BE COURTEOUS.
- B. No swimming, diving or water skiing from the docks or launch area.
- C. Boat slips are fee reserved only.
- D. Boats are docked at owner's risk.
- E. No loading/unloading or boat parking at fishing dock.
- F. Boat slip area is reserved for only boat slip renters.

Swim Area and Beach:

- A. All members, dependents and guests swim at their own risk. No lifeguard on duty.
- B. All swimming is confined to the roped-off swim area. Only enter or exit the swim area from the sandy beach.
- C. No boats or personal watercraft in the swim area, beach, or within 150 feet of the swim area.
- D. The swim platform is for all to enjoy. Any vandalism will not be tolerated.

Picnic Area:

- A. Fires must be contained to the barbeque pits only and extinguished properly.
- B. Picnic areas are on a first-come, first-served basis. Gazebos can be reserved with a \$50 refundable cleaning fee.
- C. Please pick up your litter and wash the tables if needed.

Guests:

- A. A member must accompany a guest at all times.
- B. A member is responsible for their guests and the facilities.
- C. A member anticipating more than 10 guests must contact the board of directors 2 weeks prior to the function. No parties or functions on major holidays.
- D. Special consideration is given to churches, schools or civic groups.

Misuse of the Park:

- A. Any misuse of the park may result in fines, revocation and/or suspension of park membership refund. A member may be held financially responsible.
- B. Memberships are non-transferable may not be used collectively. Sharing decals or keys is theft of park services.
- C. Falsifying any portion of the park application is cause for revocation.
- D. Misuse is considered failure to observe rules, regulations and by-laws of the park or any act of theft, destruction, or vandalism of park facilities or property by member, dependent, or guest.
- E. Any type of verbal abuse to other members, caretaker, gate tenders, or board members may result in revocation of membership.
